Student Health Checkup Schedule and Instructions for the First Semester

<Schedule>

- ◆ First-year undergraduates (excluding third-year transfer students) have different health checkup examination than others. So please make a reservation for the "First-year Undergraduate" Health Checkup. If you are not available to attend the health checkup, we will increase the slots of "First-year Undergraduate" health checkup after May. However, the Health Checkup reservation slot is limited, so please make your appointment as soon as possible on the "First-year Undergraduates" day and attend.
- ◆ The issuance of the Health Checkup Certificate will take approximately two weeks after the examination. If you need the certificate for purposes of job hunting, etc., we recommend that you attend the health checkup as early as possible.
- ♦ Students who have status of the University staff (those who work for Chiba-University Hospital or work more than 20 hours per week at Chiba-University as of April and May) should take the Staff Health Checkup instead of Student Health Checkup. For details, please contact your administrative office or Safety and Health Organization (SHO).
- ◆ Working students may substitute the university's student health checkup by submitting a copy of their workplace health examination results to the SHO by the end of January of the relevant academic year.

<Instructions>

- ◆ Before taking the Health Checkup, please complete the on-line questionnaire and make a reservation via university network (Website). The start date for reservations will be announced around April 10 via Chiba University Web Mail. Instructions for on-line input can be found in the "Web User Manual" on the SHO website.
- ◆ If you have not completed the online medical questionnaire or made a reservation for your health checkup, you won't be able to undergo the examination. If you are unable to do so in advance due to circumstances such as being unable to come to university, please contact SHO for assistance.
- ◆ Exchange students, and graduate students at the joint graduate school needs to apply by early April. Please check with your faculty/administrative office by application deadline.
- ◆ Exchange students, specially registered non-degree students, research students, and other students must obtain a separate "Integrated Authentication Account" to use this system. Please check with your faculty/administrative office by application deadline.
- ◆ Students who are subjected to the Special Health Checkup (Ionizing Radiation, Genetic Modification, Pathogen and Hazardous substances handler) will receive notification for the health checkup from your academic advisor or the responsible administrative office.
 - *Particular Special Checkup (Hazardous substances Handling Health Checkups) will be conducted at second semester.
- ◆ Please check the important notes for the health checkup on the website when completing the medical questionnaire.
