

Student Health Checkup Results, Confirmation and Issuance of Certificates

< Health Checkup results on the Website >

1. You can view your health checkup results from the device connected to campus network.
2. You can access “Health Support System HM-neo” or from Safety and Health Organization (SHO) Website <http://hschome-gw.hsc.chiba-u.jp/>

3. The results of Special Health Checkup (Genetic Modification, Pathogens, Ionizing Radiation, and Hazardous substances handler) cannot be issued from the certificate auto-issuing machine, so please be sure to check them on the Web.
4. If you have taken the General Health Checkup in Nishi-Chiba Campus, the results can be confirmed in about 2 weeks. However, if you have taken the Special Health Checkup or blood test, it takes about a month to confirm the results. In addition, it takes about 5 weeks to confirm the results taken in the Matsudo and Inohana campus. You will be notified individually by Chiba University mail when you can start viewing your health checkup results.
5. Those who have abnormalities found in the General Health Checkup are required to undergo a follow-up examination. The time needed for evaluation may vary depending on the test items, but the results of the examination will typically be available within one to two weeks after the examination.

< Issuance of Health Checkup Certificate >

1. General Health Checkup certificates can be issued by using the “Certificate Issuance Service” from the machines located at the Student Support Division (Nishi-Chiba), the Hall on the 1st floor of the Pharmaceutical Sciences Building II (Inohana), and in front of the office on the 1st floor of the Faculty of Horticulture Building F (Matsudo). (Free of charge)
You can also use the multi-copy machines installed in convenience stores nationwide. (Charge needed).

2. Certificates for Research students, Special research students, Exchange students, and Specially registered non-degree students, or certificates in English or on designated forms cannot be issued by the Automated issuance machine. If you need such certificates, please apply at the Health Center of SHO. (Applications will be started from the end of May.)
